Molly Limpet's Ltd is committed to being an inclusive supplier, for all clients' needs.

From a large collection of over 50,000 garments, built over twenty+ years, we are asked daily to supply for a wide range of adult and junior sizes (more than any single high street retailer can provide), for clients who are non-binary, clients who are trans, clients who are cancer survivors having undergone single or double mastectomies, clients with alopecia, clients with prosthetic limbs, clients from multi-heritage backgrounds, clients who are neuro-divergent who navigate sensory overload from certain fabrics/fits, wheelchair-users, Little People... this is not an exhaustive list.

We welcome all to our busy Emporium, and share the joy of all our clients in bringing entertainment to our communities across the UK via both amateur and professional projects. We all share a part in making theatre a fully inclusive experience for all, and are pleased and proud to say that the majority of the time, we achieve this, but we understand the work still needed to be done.

We work *with* clients, not *for* them. If you need Molly Limpet's Ltd to assist you with cast members who may have additional access requirements for costumes, please discuss this with us at **quote stage**, declaring what allowances you have made as their chosen company and safe space, to allow us to realise your brief. Inclusivity is not simply saying yes to someone's access needs, and then expecting someone else to do all the work: it is a collaborative process that requires a higher level of communication, more time and understanding, and additional funds.

We expect productions to demonstrate meaningful and authentic inclusive casting, with proper acknowledgement and respect for the ethnic and cultural backgrounds of the communities being represented. While licensing terms may not always encourage this approach, it is important that Black, Brown, and other under-represented communities are given the opportunity to portray roles that reflect their own lived experiences, histories, and identities. Authentic representation on stage matters, both for performers and for the audiences who rarely see themselves represented truthfully and equitably.
